**-Maintained client food access at three time per month through May and four times per month in June at our food bank where we served 13,872 people during this time period**  
**-Provided weekly food to 65 New Vista Fullerton transitional homeless clients; 18 adult homeless clients; 57 Anaheim clients; and 36 rapid re-housing clients in the form of protein (milk & meat), fruits, formula and vegetables**

**We had no obstacles, nor challenges. Increasing food access for our clients is a blessing.**
- Describe any unintended positive outcomes as a result of the efforts supported by this grant.  
**Having the flexibility to purchase exactly what we needed at the time that we needed it rather than hoping and waiting for in-kind donations to arrive is definitely a positive. This made client service more consistent.**
- Describe the overall effect this grant has had on your organization.  
**This grant has allowed us to cover all the food that needed to be purchased (i.e. not donated from in-kind sources) by our organization for the first 6 months of this year! We are so appreciative to the S. L. Gimbel Foundation for this partnership.**
- Tell us a few success stories that made an impact on your organization and/or community as a result of this grant.  
**A former client, Adam, recently reached out to us in order to give back to the community through our programs. Adam is the son of a woman who stayed at our New Vista site with his mother and his two sisters when he was in the seventh grade. Before Adam and his family stayed with us at our New Vista Transitional Housing, they lived from motel-to-motel throughout the North Orange County area for over 3 years. Finally Adam's mother reached out to us for help and they soon moved in. During Adam and his family's time at New Vista, his mother was able to find a full-time job after using the resources that Pathways was able to provide including the weekly food distribution. She followed all of our guidelines and found permanent housing after staying with us six months. Since Adam's mother graduated from our program, the family has retained permanent housing.**

**Now 24, Adam is currently a student at California State University Fullerton and will be graduating in the Spring of 2014. He is doing a summer internship volunteering his time with Pathways to give back what he and his family once received. Adam said that “without his family’s time at Pathways, he doesn’t know where he would be today.”**
