With the purchase of the 200 warm-ups for the track and cross country runners, all runners on both teams during their respective season were able to suit up with the new team warm-up. In the past, only 25% of our athletes could afford a warm-up jacket and pants, leaving 75% of our team wearing their own jackets of miscellaneous designs, jeans, or non-school colors sweats. The school or teams did not provide warm-ups to borrow. The current economic conditions and constraints on our poor families made purchasing team warm-ups a luxury many could not afford. However, the grant fund allowed both teams to accomplish the goal of supplying a warm-up for every athlete (195) on La Sierra's track or cross country team.

What were the challenges and obstacles you encountered (if any) in attaining your goals and objectives.

Prior to grant approval, the biggest challenged for the school, coaches and athletes was providing warmth for each runner during inclement weather as they competed. Once we received the grant money we were extremely fortunate that we didn't encounter any challenges in achieving the goal of offering and/or dressing every athlete in a new warm-up during their competitive season.

Describe the overall effect this grant has had on your organization.


Our student-athletes work hard both in the classroom, on the track, and during the cross country season. When all the runners were outfitted in a new warm-up, it provided additional pride as they wore their own special team warm-ups and uniform. The recognition by the school staff, students and administration while wearing the warm-ups on racing days added to their positive responsiveness of being affiliate with either the track and field team or the cross country team.

The S. L. Gimbel Foundation grant which provided warm ups for our lower income student-athletes significantly enhanced the quality of life for our student-athletes. The pride they demonstrated by being dressed as a team lifted their confidence, performance and increased their appreciation for giving back to others.
