MARVIN E LEGGETT JR spent his entire 40-year teaching career in the English Departments of two high schools--Norte Vista and La Sierra--in the Alvord Unified School District of Riverside, CA. This dedicated educator and avid book collector was known especially for his Science Fiction and Fantasy classes, as well as for his classes in the Humanities. He wanted to pass on his love of learning to Alvord students now, and also in the years to come...with these scholarships.

LINDA WILSON was a passionate advocate for both Music and the Performing Arts in Riverside and in Los Angeles, CA. **JAMES WILSON**, Linda's father, was a steadfast worker in the auto industry in Riverside, CA. Both were devoted friends of Mr. Leggett and contributed to this Fund.

DESCRIPTION OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS:

- This Scholarship provides a **TOTAL of \$4000 @ \$1000 per year over FOUR years** -- for the recipient from any of the three high schools of Alvord Unified School District in Riverside, CA.
- This Scholarship provides **\$1000 EACH YEAR** for **FOUR years**, if the recipient 1) remains a full time student at a community college and/or a four-year college or university, and 2) maintains a GPA of 3.0. This is *not automatic*: you **MUST** contact Inland Empire Community Foundation with your GPA and brief summary of the just-past year of college, after each & every year... for a **potential total of \$4000**.
- This scholarship shall be used for **educational expenses**, such as tuition, fees, books, school-related supplies i.e. technology, musical instrument or housing--via the college or university you are attending.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA: The applicant shall...

- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.25
- Be a Senior at Norte Vista or La Sierra or Hillcrest High School in AUSD of Riverside, CA
- Demonstrate financial need (include FAFSA amount to be awarded and why)
- *Preference will be given to those considering careers in (1) education (teaching), (2) in the creative arts such as writing, speaking, dancing, performing, music, photography, film, drawing/painting, pottery etc. (3) community service, (4) environmental protection, (5) peace studies.
- *If you are undecided and searching for your major or direction in life, you may still apply.

The **APPLICATION PACKET** should include:

1. Completed application
2. Two letters of recommendation (from teachers, counselors, or unrelated community members)
3. Transcripts (including GPA and SAT or ACT test scores)
4. Essay (see application form for specific instructions)
