Application Deadline: April 3, 2020

The Riverside Construction Company, Harmon/Lounsbury Scholarship Fund provides college financial assistance to outstanding graduating seniors from Riverside who are pursuing a college education in engineering, particularly in the area of construction or civil engineering.

Recipients receive a scholarship award to an accredited public or private institution of higher learning. The scholarship awards are outright grant awards. No services will be required as a consequence of receiving the award. Scholarship awards are for tuition, books, education fees, and/or living expenses. The minimum scholarship award is \$1,000.

Scholarship criteria:

- Minimum 3.0 G.P.A.
- High school graduating senior planning to attend a college or university full time
- Course of study in engineering; priority given to construction or civil engineering
- Exhibit community and school involvement.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Work experience is a consideration.

- 1) Completed application form
- 2) 2 letters of recommendation
- 3) Transcript
- 4) Essay
