The Dr. Horace Jackson Legacy Scholarship Fund is established to provide financial assistance in the form of scholarships to graduating high school students from John W. North who demonstrate a desire to continue learning and a deep commitment toward a better, more inclusive world.

The selected student will have shown an interest in activism and participation in social justice efforts in school and their community.

Recipients receive a \$1,500 scholarship award to an accredited two-year college. The scholarship awards are outright grant awards. No services will be required as a consequence of receiving the award. Scholarship awards are for tuition, books, education fees, and/or living expenses.

Scholarship criteria:

- Minimum 2.5 G.P.A.
- Graduating senior from John W. North High School
- Planning to attend a two-year college as a full-time student
- Exhibit involvement in community and/or school activities, which may include participation in an Academy program at North High.
- Demonstrate financial need

The application packet should include:

- 1) Completed application form
- 2) 1 letter of recommendation
- 3) Personal statement telling us about yourself and why you should be selected for this scholarship (statement can be written, video or powerpoint presentation)
- 4) Transcript (unofficial is acceptable)
