



Desert Outreach Foundation Scholarship Information and Criteria

The Desert Outreach Foundation, founded in 1999, is dedicated to improving the Coachella Valley community by assisting and supporting young people of merit, in need with their career & academic endeavors. In 2022, the Desert Outreach Foundation Scholarship Fund will award a minimum of five, one-year scholarships to students who live in the Coachella Valley. Scholarship award amounts may range between \$1,000 and \$2,000 depending on the number of scholarships awarded.

Who is eligible to receive the scholarship?

The Fund provides financial assistance in the form of scholarships to students residing in the Coachella Valley who are seeking an undergraduate/graduate degree either within or outside of the Valley. Scholarships are to be used for education-related expenses such as tuition, educational equipment and supplies.

Scholarship Criteria and Procedures

Applicants will be selected based on the following:

- Financial need
- Scholastic achievement
- Community service
- Full time student

- Essay
- Career or educational goal
- Letter of recommendation
- Interview (if needed)

How are scholarship recipients selected?

Scholarship recipients are selected by a scholarship committee composed of educators and community members. Applications are reviewed competitively. A rating system is used which includes: Financial Need, Scholastic Achievement, Community Service, Essay and Letters of Recommendation. Financial Need is given the highest priority in the rating process.

How to apply for the scholarship and submission instructions:

Eligible students must complete: 1) An application form; 2) a letter of recommendation (from counselor and/or others not related to the applicant) that verify community service; 3) an essay; 4) transcript (unofficial is acceptable; 5) Copy of FAFSA – EFC (Estimated Family Contribution) page. Final award recipients must provide evidence of enrollment in the academic institution to which funds will be paid on behalf of the recipient.
