Engineering Scholarship Application Guidelines – 1st Year College Students
Application Deadline: April 29, 2022**

The Riverside Construction Company, Harmon/Lounsbury Scholarship Fund provides college financial assistance to 1st year college students who are currently enrolled at California Polytechnic University- Pomona, California Polytechnic University-San Luis Obispo, California State University- Long Beach, California Baptist University, and who are pursuing a college education in engineering, particularly in the area of construction or civil engineering.

Recipients receive a scholarship award to an institution of higher learning. The scholarship awards are outright grant awards. No services will be required as a consequence of receiving the award. Scholarship awards are for tuition, books, education fees, and/or living expenses. The minimum scholarship award is \$1,000. Last year's award was \$2,000 per recipient.

Scholarship criteria:

- Minimum 3.0 G.P.A.
- 1st year college student currently enrolled at: California Polytechnic University, Pomona; California Polytechnic University, San Luis Obispo; California State University, Long Beach; California Baptist University
- Course of study in engineering; priority given to construction or civil engineering.
- Exhibit community and school involvement.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Work experience is a consideration.

- 2) 2 letters of recommendation
- 3) Transcript
- 4) Essay
