What is the Women's Giving Fund?

The Women's Giving Fund (WGF) was established in 2017 by a diverse group of professional women. Their goal was to create an inclusive opportunity for female donors to learn about women's economic security issues, focus their giving on issues impacting women and children, and experience the power of collaborative philanthropy. In celebration of IECF's 80th Anniversary, the WGF was named a Signature Fund in 2022.

Based on funds raised each year, grants are made at least annually. A contribution of \$200 or more to the WGF will enable you to participate in our annual grantmaking process as we identify and support the organizations that are most in need.
