What is the CIELO Fund?

"Cielo" means "sky" or "heaven" in Spanish. The name signals hope – sky's the limit – and gives a nod to the aspirations, resilience, and dreams that define the Inland Empire's Latino community.

The Cultivating Inland Empire Latino Opportunity (CIELO) Fund at IECF launched in 2022 at the Inland Empire Community Foundation. The CIELO Fund's mission is to uplift and invest in organizations, initiatives and ideas that are led by – and serve – Latinos in the Inland Empire. Leading the effort is CIELO Fund founder, chair, and IECF Vice Chair, Jesse Melgar, who, along with regional Latino leaders who make up the Leadership and Grantmaking Committee, have raised close to \$2 million to jumpstart the efforts within its first 2 years. Over 300 foundations, companies, colleges, universities, organizations, and individuals have supported the CIELO Fund directly.

The CIELO Fund is housed at the Inland Empire Community Foundation (IECF) and is dedicated to empowering the lives of Latinos in the Inland Empire by uplifting and investing in organizations, initiatives and ideas that are led by—and serve—Latinos in our region.



What are the benefits of the CIELO Fund?

- Support Latino led and serving nonprofit organizations doing impactful work throughout the Inland Empire
- Learn about issues impacting Latinos
- Combine your gift with others to enhance impact
- Network with other Latinos who are philanthropically minded and living their passion

Based on the funds raised, grants are made at least annually. Using "participatory grant making," several donors (including the Chair) and several nonprofits work together with IECF's Grants and Community Impact team to decide and distribute grant funding.

Funds will be disbursed based on the committee's recommendations in one or both of the following ways:

- By open call, competitive application
- By invitation only

"The CIELO Fund has raised more than \$1 million in its first annual outing. The CIELO Fund's impact has been felt in the region. It has granted \$280,000 to 25 organizations, awarded \$125,000 in scholarships to Latino college students, published original research that further fuel its reach, and worked to uplift more positive narratives for Latinos in the region through partnerships with The Desert Sun and the IE Latino Voices radio segment on KVCR/NPR."
